

Stressing Of CWR Level One

COURSE AIMS

- Have a comprehensive understanding of Track Terminology relating to Stressing
- Be able to supervise the removal/repair of Rail Defects
- Understand the correct installation of insulated Rail Joints within C. W. R.
- Be able to accurately calculate the Stress requirements including Pull Force, Pressure Reading and Original Stress Free Temperature
- Be able to understand a Restoration of Stress Certificate
